Re: Request for extension of time to hold the public meeting for North Eden Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. 13249

Dear Ms. Bose,

North Eden Hydro, LLC, requests permission for an extension of the 60 day period for holding the public meeting for North Eden Pumped Storage Hydroelectric Project, FERC No. 13249.

The applicant must hold a stakeholder meeting within 60 days of publication for approval to use the Traditional Licensing Process, as required by 18 CFR 4.38(b). In addition, the applicant is required to notify the FERC of the meeting time and place.

However, due to scheduling constraints and facility availability, meeting times are limited to a few days just before Memorial Day weekend, which the applicant fears would jeopardize optimal participation from agency and stakeholders. Because the project is located near a sensitive recreation resource, the applicant wants to ensure that public involvement is not diminished by ancillary scheduling issues that are unrelated to real and/or potential public concerns.

In light of these considerations, we propose that the said public meeting be held June 3, 2009 at 6:00 P.M. at Garden City Offices, Conference Center, 145 West Logan Road, Garden City, UT 84028.
